Destructive Weather Plan

Pelican Roost & Osprey Cove RV Parks, Naval Station Mayport

- a. The hurricane tracking information we receive is very accurate and the plans in place will afford us ample time to take appropriate action should a storm approach Naval Station Mayport.
- b. The Commanding Officer will set Condition of Readiness (COR) 5 at the beginning of hurricane season. This will remain in effect until the end of hurricane season. Please ensure your site is organized with minimal items outside during this time to ensure everyone's safety.
- c. If a storm is coming our way, installation leadership will make decisions based on the severity and timing of the storm.
- d. RV Park staff will keep you informed of the current COR and what your requirements are. As storms approach, all loose items around your RV must be stowed and you should begin to make preparations to evacuate from the base if necessary.
- e. At COR 4, all loose items must be stowed and awnings must be put away. You may be required to evacuate the RV Park at the Commanding Officer's order. If this occurs, all vehicles must leave the base immediately. Sites must be cleared of all personal items.
- f. If evacuation is not ordered at COR 4, evacuation will occur when COR 3 is established. All personal items must be cleared at this point.
- g. If you plan to leave your RV unattended in the park at any point, please ensure you have informed the office and that you have designated a person who will remove your RV should evacuation be ordered. Additionally, please ensure that all loose items are stowed any time you may leave for an extended period of time.
- h. In the case of immediate destructive weather (ie: Tornado Warning), camp host will direct patrons to take shelter in the clubhouse (Pelican Roost) or the Youth Center (Osprey Cove).
