Transition Assistance Program (TAP)

The classes are designed for military personnel who are within 24 months of retiring or 90-180 days of separating from completion of military services. It helps Service Members understand the overall transition program, the requirements to meet Career Readiness Standards, and to identify common issues Service Members and their families experience during the transition process.

Acing the Interview - 08 OCT - 1030 - 1200

This course is designed to assist you in interview preparation. It covers dressing for success, handling tough questions, and distinguishing between traditional and behavioral interviews.

Job Strategies at CAPSTONE - 17 OCT - 1030 - 1200

You will work with an employment specialist on customized resume review, relieving transition worries, realigning skills for future success, and connecting directly with hiring employees.

Command Sponsorship - 10 OCT - 1000 - 1100

The sponsorship training provided command personnel with information and training to successfully fulfill their roles as command sponsors.

SAPR/FAP/SAIL CO's Toolkit - 15 OCT - 1300 - 1430

This training fulfills command leadership's training requirements per OPNAVINST 1752.1C and 1752.2C to be completed within the first 30/90 days of command check-in. This training is focused on the CO's Toolkit for SAPR, FAP, and SAIL.

Coordinated Community Response Training (CCR) - 10 OCT - 0800 - 0900

Per OPNAVINST 1752.2C, a new 1-hour annual training is required for command leadership, including Commanding Officers and Senior Enlisted Leaders. This training aims to prevent and respond to Intimate Partner Violence (IPV) and Child Abuse and Neglect (CA/N) in military families. As part of the Coordinated Community Response (CCR), it helps stakeholders support healthy Navy families and is offered quarterly.

Child Abuse and Neglect (CA/N): Identification and Reporting and Problematic Sexual Behavior in Children and Youth (PSB-CY) - 10 OCT - 0930 - 1130

CA/N training will define the different types of child abuse/neglect; recognize warning signs and understand the mandatory reporting requirements.

PSB-CY training will define child sexual development and the continuum of childhood sexual behaviors, recognize vulnerabilities and protective factors, understand when and how to make a PSB-CY report to FAP, and your role and responsibility as a member of the PSB-CY multidisciplinary team (MDT).
